KICK START I - Introduction to Coaching Part I

AIM:

The course is designed to assist parents and coaches, to introduce children (aged 6-9 years) to fun soccer games and FUNdamental movement skills in a well-structured, stimulating and safe environment.

OBJECTIVES:

To provide coaches with the ability to:

- Plan, organise and implement a coaching session.
- Identify the stages in the development of young players at the FUNdamental phase aged between 6-9 years.
- Coach children between the age of 6-9 years in a fun, safe and friendly environment.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Kick Start 1 is the first part of a two-part Introduction to Coaching programme within the FAI's Coach Education Scheme. The course is open to all interested parties, aged 16 and over, experienced or otherwise.

DURATION/FORMAT:

8 contact hours.

There are practical aspects of the course, therefore please bring appropriate attire for both indoor and outdoor use to allow you to participate in football-related activity.

ASSESSMENT:

No formal assessment. Full attendance is compulsory to gain certification.

COURSE FEE:

€45 per person.




